The trials of the Covid Pandemic have inspired the Pat's team to host this new Thanksgiving meal event, but serving the community is not something new to Pat's Pizza and Bistro Bethlehem. "We have been active members of the community. We've done similar events in the past where we handed out food to hundreds of families. Again, free of charge. No criteria to be met," says Pat's owner Yannis Kyziridis. "We are going through tough times with the pandemic, and we're not sure who is in real need for a meal. We'll do what we do, and will provide to the people in need."

The 200 meals will be served onsite at Pat's Pizza and Bistro located at 1426 W Broad St, Bethlehem on Thursday, November 26th, 2020. The Pat's team encourages those who do not have transportation services available to them to reach out by way of email or Facebook, as Pat's is prepared to make a limited number of deliveries to those who do not have a way of getting to the location.
